## Terroir

Area: 60 ha. Average age of the vineyard: 45 years old. Nature of the soil: clay-limestone on the high plateaus of Entre-Deux-Mers. Winegrowing : Taille bordelaise with two astes. Leaving, green harvest. Harvest selected by sort of berries.

## Vinification and maturation

Vinification in thermoregulated stainless steel vats. Pre-fermentation maceration at low temperature. Breeding 12 to 16 months.

## Other information

Since 1750, the Aubert family has grown their vines on the Rive Droite de Bordeaux. The creation of La Cuvée La Grande Dame has naturally imposed itself, to highlight the women of the family who contributed to the development of the family vineyard, and Vanessa Aubert who wanted to pay tribute to them through this vintage.
